The top 25-30 students will be selected for an interview. They can receive a maximum score of 20 points

Max points (TEAS+ Prerequisites + interview) = 100 + Max Bonus POINTS =16
MAX POINTS FOR ADMISSION =116

The 16 applicants with the highest points who have satisfied all requirements will be offered acceptance to the program. The remaining will be placed on the alternate list.

Note: Being chosen as an alternate only includes this current applicant year. Student will be expected to reapply if not accepted this year.
